



Subjects of study and number of teachers teaching the subject











## Summary of findings and action taken:

The Academic Audit was conducted by the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of the college with the help of questionnaires shared with all teachers and librarian, feedback from different stakeholders and student surveys.

The college premises were mostly closed due to Covid 19 and the resultant lockdown. In spite of the closure, teachers visited the college on select dates to help in the conduct of the university examinations for those few students who had opted to take the exams in physical mode. Many teachers were also assigned duties related to overseeing the timely upload of the examination question papers on to the examination portal. Moreover, classes were not hampered in a major way as teachers continued to take classes in online mode. Many teachers were seemingly less confident with using ICT tools to start with but were found to have gained confidence with time. Results of students was satisfactory and better than expected in many cases. This probably had to do with the fact the students could write their exams from the comfort of their homes. A good number of teachers continued their research in online mode and even published papers and participated in online conferences and webinars. Given the total dependence of academic activities on online mode of teaching, it was decided to augment the ICT resources of the college. Once the lockdown, period was over and the college reponed, teachers were encouraged to adopt more ICT-centric learning methods in their classes. The number of computers were also needed to be augmented and the process for the same was initiated.
