Report on International Women's Day Program 2023






Celebration of Anti Tobbaco Day on 31st May 2023





1st speaker of the programme was Mrs. Sujata Koley from Department of Bengali. She spoke about the history of Women's Day and why it is celebrated all over the world.








Celebration of Yoga Day on 21.06.2024



Celebration of Independence Day on 15.08.2024


